REKHA GUPTA SWORN IN AS DELHI CM, 6 CABINET MINISTERS ALSO TAKE OATH

Diary Times Desk : BJP's debutant legislator Rekha Gupta was sworn in as Delhi Chief Minister on Thursday in a grand show of strength that marks the party's return to power in the city after more than 26 years.

The ceremony at the historic Ramlila Ground was attended by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the top BJP brass and NDA chief ministers. Gupta is Delhi's fourth woman chief minister.

After the administration of oath by Lt Governor V K Saxena, Gupta became the 9th Chief Minister of Delhi. The 50-year-old MLA from Shalimar Bagh is also the only woman in the NDA team of chief ministers. Besides Gupta, six newly elected MLAs -- Parvesh Verma who defeated AAP supremo Arvind Kejriwal from the New Delhi seat, Ashish Sood, Pankaj Singh, Manjinder Singh Sirsa, Kapil Mishra and Ravinder Indraj -- were sworn-in as cabinet ministers.

The new Council of Ministers headed by Gupta is likely to hold its first meeting at the Delhi Secretariat on Thursday evening and could implement the Mahila Samriddhi Yojna, under which eligible women will get a monthly payment of Rs 2,500, and Ayushman Bharat health insurance scheme, party sources claimed. Among those who attended the event were chief ministers of states ruled by the BJP and its NDA allies -- Maharashtra's Devendra Fadnavis, Andhra Pradesh's Chandrababu Naidu, Goa's Pramod Sawant, Haryana's Nayab Singh Saini and Meghalaya's Conrad Sangma. Deputy chief ministers of Uttar Pradesh Keshav Prasad Maurya and Brajesh Pathak, and Andhra Pradesh's Pawan Kalyan were present too. Gupta, 50, was chosen as Leader of the House in the newly constituted 8th Delhi Assembly, in a meeting of the BJP legislature party on Wednesday.

Diary Times Desk : Uttar Pradesh Finance Minister Suresh Kumar Khanna on Thursday tabled a Rs 8,08,736-crore Budget for the financial year 2025-26 in the state assembly, with a focus on research & development and Information Technology.

Mr Khanna in his Budget speech said around 22 per cent of the Budget has been allocated for development purposes, 13 per cent for education, 11 per cent for agriculture and related services, while six per cent has been allocated for health.

"We have focussed on research, development and Information Technology in the Budget," said Khanna.

Mr Khanna began his address by praising Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath and highlighting developments in the state under his leadership. He also mentioned the ongoing Maha Kumbh as he began his address. He described the Kumbh as not only a cultural and religious event but also a rare astronomical occurrence symbolising India's ancient faith and cultural integrity. Mr Khanna said the total Budget outlay for financial year 2025-26 is 9.8 per cent higher than the Budget outlay for FY25.

The size of the state's Budget for 2024-25 was Rs 7,36,437 crore that included new schemes worth Rs 24,863.57 crore. Mr Khanna said the state government will develop an Artificial Intelligence City and set up a park for technological research in cyber security.

There are also provisions for the modernisation of the Legislative Assembly as well as the development of smart classes and laboratories in schools and polytechnics. Mr Khanna informed that work will be done to develop 58 municipal bodies of the state as ideal smart municipal bodies. For this, a provision of Rs 2.50 crore per municipal body amounting to a total of Rs 145 crore was proposed.

KHARGE SLAMS MODI GOVT OVER CHINA POLICY, **ALLEGES NATIONAL SECURITY RISK**

Diary Times Desk : Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge on Thursday accused Prime Minister Narendra Modi of putting India's national security and territorial sovereignty at risk by adopting soft policy towards China, which he said is settling new 90 villages on Arunachal Pradesh border. The Congress chief alleged the Prime Minister is adopting the soft policy towards China instead of taking a tough stance. "You are adopting the policy of 'red salute' instead of 'red eye' towards China!" he alleged. He said the Modi government is putting India's "national security, territorial sovereignty and integrity" at risk. He claimed that the allegation levelled by him against the PM is based on facts. BIMAN BANGLADESH FLIGHT EMERGENCY LANDING: PASSENGERS LEAVE BY ANOTHER PLANE 19 HOURS LATER

Diary Times Desk : A replacement aircraft from Biman Bangladesh Airlines took off for Dubai on Thursday with nearly 400 passengers after their earlier flight made an emergency landing at Nagpur airport following detection of smoke in the hold area. On Wednesday night when flight BG-347 was on its way to Dubai from Dhaka, the pilot received an alert from the fire alarm system forcing him to land the aircraft at Nagpur airport at 10.45 pm with 396 passengers and 12 crew members. A full emergency was declared at the airport and the aircraft, after landing, was taken to an isolation bay where the passengers disembarked safely and the cargo was offloaded. Although smoke was reported in the aircraft's hold, a thorough examination showed no signs of fire, officials said. Almost 19 hours after the emergency landing, passengers continued with their journey.

71 PER CENT OF NEWLY SWORN-IN DELHI MINISTERS FACE CRIMINAL CASES



Diary Times Desk : Five, including the chief minister, out of seven newly sworn-in ministers in Delhi have declared criminal cases against them, while two are billionaires, according to poll rights body Association for Democratic Reforms. The findings are based on the selfsworn affidavits submitted by the ministers ahead of the 2025 Delhi Assembly elections. According to the analysis by the ADR, five out of seven ministers (71 per cent) have declared criminal cases against them, while two ministers (29 per cent) are billionaires. The report highlighted that five ministers, including Chief Minister Rekha Gupta, have declared criminal cases against them. Among them, one minister, Ashish Sood, faces serious criminal charges. On the financial front, two ministers, accounting for 29 per cent of the cabinet, are billionaires. The minister with the highest declared total assets is Manjinder Singh Sirsa from Rajouri Garden with assets worth Rs 248.85 crore and the minister with the lowest declared total assets is Kapil Mishra from Karawal Nagar constituency with assets worth Rs 1.06 crore.

BJP Questions Lokayukta Clean Chit To Siddaramaiah, Congress Hits Back

Diary Times Desk : The Lokayukta's clean chit to Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah in the alleged MUDA land scam has triggered a political slugfest, with the BJP alleging that the state government handpicked the officers investigating the case and the Congress hitting back and saying that the issue was politically motivated. The Lokayukta on Thursday submitted an 11,000-page closure report to the Special Court for MLAs and MPs in Bengaluru in the Mysuru Urban Development Authority (MUDA) case against Siddaramaiah, his wife BM Parvathi, brother-in-law Mallikarjunswamy and landowner J Devaraju. The allegation is that Siddaramaiah's wife was allotted 14 sites in Vijayanagar Layout, an upmarket area in Mysuru, as compensation for the use of 3.16 acres of land in Kesare village near the city. An anticorruption activist had complained that this had caused a loss of Rs 45 crore to the state. Siddaramaiah has maintained that there was no wrongdoing in the transactions, asserting that the plots were gifted to his wife by her brother. Writing to one of the complainants, the Lokayukta had said on Wednesday that there was not enough evidence to conduct an investigation against Siddaramaiah and the charges seemed civil in nature and not "suitable for criminal charges".

Trump Declares Himself "King" After Move Snubbing **New York Governor**

Diary Times Desk : A recent declaration by Donald Trump has raised questions about his views on presidential authority. In a statement on Truth Social, Trump proclaimed himself "king" after his administration's efforts to dismantle New York City's congestion pricing program. This program, designed to raise funds for the city's aging mass transit system, has been a point of contention between Trump's administration and local authorities. Trump's announcement, which included the "CONGESTION PRICING IS DEAD. phrase Manhattan, and all of New York, is SAVED. LONG LIVE THE KING!" was further amplified by the White House's official X account. The account shared a mock Time magazine cover featuring Trump adorned with a crown and the caption "long live the king." Adding to the controversy, White House deputy chief of staff Taylor Budowich shared an Al-generated image of Trump wearing a crown and regal cape. In a letter to New York Governor Kathy Hochul, Transportation Secretary Sean Duffy expressed the president's objections to the congestion pricing program, labeling it "backwards and unfair" and a "slap in the face to working-class Americans and small business owners." Duffy claimed that federal officials would discuss plans with the state for the "orderly cessation of toll operations."

"Was Sleeping": Trump Accuses Ukraine's Zelensky Of Treating US Envoy "Rudely"

"Scott Bessent actually went there and was treated rather rudely, because essentially, they told him 'no'," Trump told reporters on Air Force One. "And Zelensky was sleeping and unavailable to meet him. Bessent "traveled many hours on the train, which is a dangerous trip.

India Responds After Illegal Migrants Deported By US Seek "Help" In Panama



Diary Times Desk : India is working closely with the authorities in Panama to ensure the well-being of Indian migrants deported by the United States to the Latin American country. The Indian embassy in Panama said the migrants are safe and secure at the hotel where they are detained. "Panamanian authorities have informed us that a group of Indians have reached Panama from US, They are safe and secure at a hotel with all essential facilities. Embassy team has obtained consular access. We are working closely with the host Government to ensure their wellbeing," the embassy said in a post on X. The statement came a day after a report claimed nearly 300 individuals from various countries, including Iran, India, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Pakistan, Afghanistan, and China, who were deported from the United States under President Donald Trump, were confined in a hotel in Panama. Some of those deportees resorted to displaying desperate messages for "help" on their hotel room windows, stating "We are not save (sic) in our country".

"One Of The Hardest Days": **Israelis Gather For Return Of** Hostage Bodies

Diary Times Desk : Dozens of flag-waving Israelis gathered under a stormy sky Thursday lining the route of a convoy bringing home the bodies of four deceased hostages handed over by Hamas in Gaza. The Palestinian militants had handed over black coffins they said contained the bodies of Shiri Bibas and her two young boys, Kfir and Ariel -- who became symbols of the ordeal that has gripped Israel since the Gaza war began. The Red Crossmediated handover, which Hamas said also included the body of elderly captive Oded Lifshitz, took place at a former cemetery in the south Gaza city of Khan Yunis. It is the first handover of bodies by Hamas since its October 7, 2023 attack on Israel triggered the Gaza war.

Mt Everest's Snow Cover Receded By 150 Metres This Winter, Show Satellite Images

Diary Times Desk : Snow cover atop Mount Everest retreated by 150 metres, indicating a lack of snow accumulation during the winter season of 2024-2025, researchers have noted. Analysing NASA satellite images from October 2023 till early January 2025, trends illustrated "a rise in snow line through January in both 2024 and 2025", glaciologist Mauri Pelto, a professor of environmental science at Nichols College, US, wrote in a blog post on February 2. At 8,849 metres above sea level, Mount Everest is the tallest point on Earth. The Himalayan peak is located between Nepal and Tibet. Snow line' refers to the boundary or elevation at which snow permanently stays on a mountain. A 'rising snow line' -- in which snow melts at lower heights, forcing the snow line boundary up a mountainside -- is suggestive of a warming climate. Pelto said that warmer and drier conditions have been prevailing in recent winters, including those of 2021, 2023, 2024 and 2025, which are driving a reduced snow cover, higher snow lines and increased forest fires.

Donald Trump Says Trade Deal With China 'Possible' Amid Tariff Tensions

Diary Times Desk : US President Donald Trump suggested on Wednesday that a trade deal was "possible" with China -- a key target in the US leader's tariffs policy. In 2020, the United States had already agreed to "a great trade deal with China" and a new deal was "possible," Trump told reporters. One month into his second term in office, Trump has threatened sweeping tariffs on allies and adversaries alike targeting China as well as neighbors Canada and Mexico, and the European Union -- and using levies as his main policy tool for lowering the massive US trade deficit. At the beginning of February, he slapped additional customs duties of 10 percent on all products imported from China. He is also threatening to impose 25 percent tariffs on all imported cars, and similar or higher duties on pharmaceuticals and semiconductors as he turns up the heat on some of the biggest US trading partners. Punjab dismisses 52 cops for corruption, 42 are constables

Diary Times Desk : The Punjab Police have dismissed 52 personnel over the past 10 days for involvement in corruption, criminal activities or prolonged absenteeism, Director General of Police Gaurav Yadav said on Wednesday. Addressing the media here, the DGP said the action aligned with Chief Minister Bhagwant Mann's directions for ensuring transparency, accountability and integrity in public service. Following the Aam Aadmi Party's poor performance in the Delhi Assembly elections, the Mann government in Punjab has intensified crackdown on corruption. The AAP had won the 2022 Assembly poll in Punjab on the promise of eradicating corruption, particularly among the "black sheep" in uniform. However, the latest dismissals are limited to officials up to the rank of inspector. Yadav said the dismissed officials included one inspector, five assistant sub-inspectors, four head-constables and 42 constables across various districts. The highest seven dismissals are in Ludhiana -four under the Commissionerate of Police and three in the Ludhiana-Rural wing. Five police personnel have been dismissed in Patiala, followed by four each in Jalandhar and Hoshiarpur.

Another case falls flat: 41 accused of Panchkula riots acquitted

Diary Times Desk : The court of Chief Judicial Magistrate (CJM), Panchkula, has acquitted 41 people of violence committed in the aftermath of conviction of Dera Sacha Sauda chief Gurmeet Ram Rahim Singh for rape in 2017. The police claimed that the accused were followers of Ram Rahim. More than 40 people were killed in the riots and 152 cases were registered across Panchkula, but there has been no conviction so far. The FIR in the present case was registered on the complaint of ASI Prakash Chand, who had stated that around 5 pm-5.30 pm on August 25, 2017, Head Constable Vikramjeet Singh and Home Guard Sukhwinder Singh informed him that hundreds of people had entered the Industrial Area from Sector 11/14, Panchkula, and were armed with sticks and rods. They allegedly vandalised CCTV cameras and manhandled policemen. However, the police managed to apprehend some of the individuals and seized their weapons. The accused faced the trial for rioting, using criminal force against police personnel, disobedience of order promulgated under Section 144, CrPC, and Sections 3 and 4 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act.

23 ready mix concrete plants violate pollution norms, face Rs 1.90-cr fine

Diary Times Desk : A total of 23 ready mix concrete (RMC) plants - 17 in Panipat district and six in Karnal district – have been found violating pollution norms near Dadlana village, close to the Indian Oil Corporation (IOCL) refinery. The violations were revealed in a joint inspection report by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Haryana State Pollution Control Board (HSPCB) and the district administration, conducted on the directions of the National Green Tribunal (NGT). The HSPCB has served closure notices to all the RMC plants and recommended an environmental compensation of Rs 1.90 crore on 19 plants – 14 in Panipat and five in Karnal. The inspections were initiated following a complaint by Deepak, a resident of Dadlana village.



AAP leader shoots dead Sarpanch's husband in Abohar, protesters block highway

Diary Times Desk : An AAP leader allegedly shot and killed the husband of a village Sarpanch in the Kallar Khera village, 27 km from Abohar, on Thursday. The suspect, Manoj Kumar, is reportedly the block president of the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP). The victim, Shankar Jalap, succumbed to his injuries while being taken to Sri Ganganagar. His body was later taken to Civil Hospital Abohar for the postmortem examination. His wife, Poonam, who is also a member of AAP, was elected Sarpanch in last year's Panchayat election. Initial reports suggest that a dispute arose in the village regarding the construction of a drain. While the village Panchayat was attempting to resolve the matter, Manoj Kumar reportedly lost his temper when his demands were disregarded. He allegedly drew a weapon and shot Jalap. The police are investigating the incident, and SSP Varinder Singh Brar has assured that teams will do their best to trace the suspect. However, protesters have blocked the Abohar-Sri Ganganagar highway, disrupting interstate traffic, and are demanding the arrest of the suspect.

Chandigarh grenade attackers received funds, weapons from foreign-based accused: NIA

Diary Times Desk : The National Investigation Agency (NIA) has made a significant claim in the Chandigarh grenade attack case, stating that the accused, Rohan Masih and Vishal Masih, received funds, weapons, and explosives from foreign-based individuals to carry out terror acts in Punjab and Chandigarh. According to NIA, the accused were part of a larger criminal conspiracy hatched by Harwinder Singh alias Rinda and Harpreet Singh alias Happy Passia to assassinate a retired Punjab police officer in Chandigarh. The investigation revealed that Rohan Masih had been conducting reconnaissance of the target's house since June 2024, along with an associate of Harpreet Singh. NIA has sought a production warrant for the two accused, who allegedly hurled a grenade at a house in Sector 10D, Chandigarh, on September 11, 2024. Initially, the Chandigarh Police investigated the case, but it was later handed over to the NIA by the Ministry of Home Affairs. The agency has found incriminating evidence, including chats, videos, photos, and foreign numbers, on the mobile phones of the accused. The data was recovered from three mobile phones seized from the accused, which were sent to Central Forensic Science Laboratory (CFSL) in Chandigarh.

Congress lodges complaint with poll panel against Saini

Diary Times Desk : The Congress has lodged a complaint with the Election Commission State regarding alleged violation of the Model Code of Conduct (MCC) against CM Nayab Singh Saini. In the complaint addressed to the state Chief Election Officer of Haryana, Congress mayoral candidate from Rohtak Surajmal sought action against Saini. "I want to bring to your cognisance that Haryana Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini has violated the Model Code of Conduct. While addressing a nomination meeting of Mayor and municipal councillors at Rohtak on February 17, the Chief Minister had stated that the government would make the provision for grant of Rs 2,100 per head to the women of the state in the upcoming budget and implement the same from the coming year after the budget, which is a clear violation of the election rules and the MCC," he said in his complaint. The Congress leader maintained that the CM's statement could adversely affect the fairness of the election process. "It is a serious matter as per the MCC and requires immediate action. I, therefore, request you to get a thorough probe conducted in this regard and take appropriate legal steps in order to maintain the impartiality of the election process," he said.

Haryana seeks special package to achieve 'Water Safe State' goal

Diary Times Desk : Haryana Public Health Engineering Minister Ranbir Gangwa has reiterated the state's commitment to becoming a 'Water Safe State' before 2047, with ongoing expansions in Jal Jeevan Mission, AMRUT Yojana and canalbased drinking water projects. Speaking at the 'Water Safe Nation' conference in Udaipur, Gangwa urged the Centre to provide a special package to strengthen Haryana's water security initiatives. Irrigation, Women and Child Development Minister Shruti Choudhry was also present at the event. Highlighting Haryana's water conservation efforts, Gangwa said, "The government is continuously taking steps to counter excessive groundwater exploitation." He noted that the state had permanently provided drinking water to 216 villages through the Ranney Well project from the Yamuna, calling it a "game changer." The minister revealed that Haryana operates.

SNOW IN SHIMLA'S KUFRI, NARKANDA; RAIN IN LOWER REACHES OF HIMACHAL PRADESH

Diary Times Desk : People of higher reaches of the state woke up to snow this morning. Tourist spots like Kufri and Narkanda are also witnessing snow, which has made the roads slippery. The administration has issued an advisory to not ply vehicles till the roads are cleared. Shimla, meanwhile, saw light drizzle. The lower parts of the state are receiving rainfall. Light to moderate spells of rain are very likely to continue over many parts of Hamirpur, Bilaspur and Mandi and over some parts of Kangra, Shimla, Solan and Sirmaur. A few spellsof light rainfall, with one or two moderate spells, are also very likely in some parts of Kullu and Chamba. The weather department has issued an orange alert for heavy rain and snow in four districts for today and predicted light to moderate rain and snow at most places till Friday mornina.

SOLAN SUPER SPECIALTY HOSPITAL PROJECT HELD UP OVER UNPAID POWER LINE SHIFT

Diary Times Desk : More than a vear after the Himachal Pradesh State Electricity Board Limited (HPSEBL) sought Rs 53.65 lakh for shifting a 33 KV power line from the construction site of an upcoming super specialty hospital at Kather Bypass, the required funds are yet to be provided. This financial hurdle has further delayed the project, which has already been facing repeated fund shortages. Initially, the power board estimated the shifting cost at Rs 38.96 lakh, but it was revised to Rs 53.65 lakh in November 2024 based on updated cost calculations for the financial year 2023-24. An official from HPSEBL stated that the cost may rise further as the work is yet to be executed. The project has already suffered delays due to financial constraints. The contractor had previously halted work for several months due to pending payments amounting to crores. Though work resumed later, the lack of funds has now stalled the power line relocation, further obstructing construction progress.

LOCALS OPPOSE PLAN TO DIVERT HOLY WATER OF MANIKARAN TO KASOL FOR COMMERCIAL USE

Diary Times Desk : The proposal of transferring water from Manikaran -- a pilgrimage site for both Hindus and Sikhs -- to Kasol in Himachal Pradesh's Kullu district to establish hot bath facility has led to a disagreement with locals opposing the move and now an alternative has been found by digging hot water spring in Kasol. It was decided in a recent meeting of the Special Area Development Authority (SADA) that a new nature park would be built in Kasol with a hot bath facility for which the water would be diverted from Manikaran through pipes. The locals threatened to launch an agitation if the holy water of Manikaran is used for commercial purposes at Kasol, a much sought after tourist destination. The distance between Manikaran and Kasol is about five kilometers. Opposing the proposal, the locals also submitted a petition in this regard to Kullu Deputy Commissioner Torul S Raveesh. Confirming the same, the deputy commissioner said that the proposal was in a preliminary stage and it was yet to be decided that the water would be diverted from which location. The locals and the BJP leaders here had maintained that even the local deities would not allow transferring of water from Manikaran to Kasol and maintained that if the hot baths have to be built, it should be set up in Manikaran.



CONG IN-CHARGE RAJNI PATIL TO VISIT STATE NEXT MONTH

Diary Times Desk : Rajni Patil, newly appointed All India Congress Committee (AICC) in-charge for party affairs in Himachal, will visit the state in the first week of March. In all probability, the process to reconstitute the dissolved Himachal Pradesh Congress Committee (HPCC) will pick up pace after her visit. It has been three and a half months since AICC president Mallikarjun Kharge dissolved the HPCC and other party units, right up to the block level. Congress workers as well as a couple of ministers have expressed their displeasure over the delay in the reconstitution of the HPCC. Public Works Department (PWD) Minister Vikramaditya Singh said that Raini would visit the state in the first week of March and he had urged her to reconstitute the HPCC at the earliest. "We have urged her to reconstitute the HPCC as soon as possible so that the stalled organisational work can be resumed to strengthen the party," he added. Chief Minister Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu, Deputy Minister Mukesh Agnihotri and Vikramaditya have met Rajni in Delhi after her appointment as the state in-charge. HPCC president Pratibha Sinah is also likely to meet her in the next couple of days. In the run-up to the reconstitution of the HPCC, leaders are likely to lobby with her to have their confidants on key positions.

HIGH SILT ACCUMULATION IN BSL CANAL AT MANDI THIS YEAR

Diary Times Desk : The BSL canal in Sundernagar of Mandi district has witnessed significant silt accumulation this year. The accumulation of silt has been attributed to a snag in the flood gates at the Pandoh dam during the rainy season last year. The Pandoh dam, a crucial water source for the BSL canal, faced issues during the last rainy season, causing an unexpected build-up of silt in the canal. Official sources confirmed that the accumulation of silt is a result of this snag, which prevented proper flow of water, leading to the sediment settling within the canal. In the chase, India got off to a solid start through Rohit Sharma and Gill. While the captain fell at the score of 41, Gill took his innings deep to take India over the line. The side faces Pakistan next on February 23 at the same venue



Mohammed Shami breaks Mitchell Starc's world record

Diary Times Desk : Jasprit Bumrah is not there but Mohammed Shami is. The veteran seamer ensured India did not miss their premier bowler in the opening match of the Champions Trophy 2025 against Bangladesh at the Dubai International Stadium. Playing his first ICC tournament since the ODI World Cup final in 2023, Shami broke Mitchell Starc's world record for the fastest to take 200 ODI wickets (in terms of balls bowled). He also became the fastest Indian to take 200 ODI wickets (in terms of matches), beating current BCCI chairman of selectors Ajit Agarkar by a huge margin. Shami achieved the milestone by dismissing Bangladesh's Jaker Ali for 68 in the 43rd over of the match on Thursday. It was a welldisquised slower ball and Jaker was through his shot way too early. All he managed to do was get it as far as the long on fielder Virat Kohli, who made no mistake. Shami pacer took 104 ODIs to get to 200 wickets. Agarkar, the previous record holder for India, had taken 133 matches. Shami also equalled Pakistan great Saqlain Mushtaq to become the joint second-fastest (in terms of matches) in the world to take 200 wickets. The fastest in the list is Australia's Mitchell Starc The left-arm pacer took 102 ODIs to complete.

Fakhar Zaman ruled out of **Champions Trophy 2025**

Pakistan, who were chasing a target of 320, fell short as they went down by 60 runs in the opener. The defending CT champions play their next match, against archrivals India, on February 23 followed by their final Group A game against Bangladesh in Rawalpindi on February 27.
